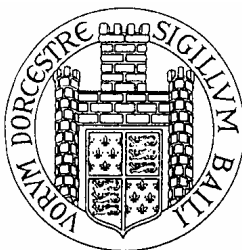


**DORCHESTER**

6. **NOTICE OF MOTION UNDER STANDING ORDER 9 – 10:10 INITIATIVE**

Councillor E.S. Jones, having given written notice in accordance with Standing Order 9, to move:

“That the Council allies itself with the 10:10 initiative and commits itself to work to reduce its carbon emissions by 10% in 2010 and calls on all other councils and local businesses to do likewise.”

(10:10 is an ambitious project to unite every sector of British society behind one simple idea: that by working together we can achieve a 10% cut in the UK’s carbon emissions in 2010.
