

The Seal of Dorchester Town Council



The centrepiece of the Seal shows a triple-towered castle whilst the shield bears the quartered arms of England and France and is taken from an original dating from 1370.

These are a version of the Royal Arms but are unusual in that they depict France Ancient rather than France Modern which shows only three fleur de lys.

The inscription means "The Seal of the Bailiffs of Dorchester".
