


**Disabled badge holders must pay for parking**


## Parking information and Town Map Car park charges 2010/11

## Parking in Dorchester

Dorchester has five Long Stay car parks and four Shoppers' car parks. All car parks are operated on a Pay and Display basis.

Pay and Display tickets are not transferable between car parks. You are advised to read the charges board in each car park you visit as these vary depending on whether the car park is designated Short Stay or Long Stay.

**Park and Ride:** A Park and Ride scheme operates Monday to Friday all year round from the Dorchester Football Stadium.

**Parking Permits:** Permits from 3 to 8 days covering all West Dorset District Council's car parks are available from the car park machines and the Tourist Information Centres, and will ease parking problems for visitors to the area.

**Season Tickets:** These are available from the Council Offices in Dorchester either on a quarterly or yearly basis, to enable the regular user to park cheaper in our Long Stay car parks throughout the West Dorset area.

**Disabled Badge Holders:** Please refer to the disabled parking notices on display in each car park.

**Larger Vehicles:** Lorries, coaches, motorhomes, caravans, caravanettes, trailers etc can be accommodated at the Top O' Town and Fairfield car parks in the commercial area. Regular users may benefit from commercial season tickets, available from Parking Services.
