4. **DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL**

(a) <u>Highway Matters</u>

To welcome Mr. A. Brown from Dorset County Council who is attending the meeting to discuss with Members outstanding Traffic Regulation Orders for the Town and to prioritise a list.

(b) Extension to the Victoria Park Residents Parking Scheme

Following the introduction of the extension of the Victoria Park Residents Parking Scheme into Coburg Road and Edward Road the five properties in Clarence Road between Edward Road and Queens Avenue now have no on-street parking. Outside 1 and 1a Clarence Road a solid yellow line was introduced about a year ago to stop all day parking on the street and to ease the route for school buses to Thomas Hardye School. Furthermore they will never be given the opportunity to join the residents parking scheme due to their location.

Dorset County Council require this Council to support the extension of the Victoria Park residents' parking scheme to this length of Clarence Road.

5. **STREET LIGHTING**

(a) Part Night Street Lighting – Alexandra Terrace

Further to Minute 32(a) to receive and note the enclosed copy letter from the County Lighting Engineer indicating that they are not prepared to review their decision regarding the switching off of the street lights in Alexandra Terrace after midnight GMT.

(b) Part Night Street Lighting – Cambridge Road

To consider a request from the residents of Cambridge Road who following five attempted break-ins at two properties are seeking this Council's support to make representations to the Dorset County Council for the street lighting to be kept on in this area.

(c) Street Lighting in Greenings Court

To receive and consider the enclosed copy correspondence regarding the replacement lighting in Greenings Court and to note that the County Council have requested SSEC to halt the works in this area until an amended design has been agreed.

(a) South Street, New Street, Trinity Street and part of High West Street

- Fell 1 Horse Chestnut at 18 Great Western Road;
- Fell 1 Beech under Section 198 due to decay at base at 23 Syward Road.

To note that the application to fell 1 Norway Maple at the rear of Nappers Court, Charles Street has been withdrawn as the Maple is a small specimen and notification is not required for its removal.
