At a Meeting of the Planning and Environment Committee held on 2nd July, 2012:

9. **MINUTES**

The Minutes of the Meeting of the Committee held on 28th May, 2012, a copy of which had been circulated to all Members of the Committee, were taken as read and were confirmed and signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

10. **DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL**

(a) Traffic Regulation Order Programme – 2012-13

The Committee noted that the following requests had been assessed and met the criteria and would be progressed to the works programme for 2012-13:

- Parking restrictions at Wessex Road, Durnover Court/Mill Street/River Crescent, Rothesay Road (St. Osmunds School), Fourgates Road, Blagdon Road (junction with Cambridge Road), South Court Avenue/Grosvenor Road, Damers Road (junction with Windsor Road), Monmouth Road/Rothesay Road/Alfred Road/Cromwell Road (parking restrictions at junctions)
- Removal of disabled bay in New Street.
- Trinity Street and Williams Avenue, No Loading & Unloading (issue due to blue badge parking)

(b) <u>Highway Amenity Maintenance Programme</u>

At a Member's request the Committee considered whether to make representation to the County Council urging them to consider the need for more than six cuts a year in the light of the number of complaints received from members of the public.

A Member suggested that some areas were being cut that should be left, particularly those growing wild flowers. Concern was also expressed that all the roundabouts in the Town now had signage on them selling advertising space, including Fordington Fields roundabout which was maintained by this Council.

Following discussion it was

RESOLVED

- (1) That the Town Clerk be requested to write to the Dorset County Council inviting them to a future meeting of this Committee to discuss Members' concerns regarding the Highway Amenity Maintenance Programme.
- (2) That the Town Clerk investigate the possibility of this Council receiving some revenue from the County Council particularly if the roundabout at Fordington Fields is sponsored.
- 3. That Members be requested to consider grassed areas in the Town which should be left uncut to encourage the growth of wild flowers.

11. WEST DORSET DISTRICT COUNCIL – TREE WORKS

(a) Applications

The Committee noted that the following tree work applications had been forwarded to Ward Members for their consideration:

- To reduce 1 Sycamore crown by 50% at 8 Sydenham Way;
- To reduce by 20% an raise the crown of 1 Yew at Princes Mews West.

(b) Approvals

The Committee noted that the following tree works had been approved by the District Council:

- Reduce height of 1 Conifer and 3 birch at 31 Queens Avenue;
- To fell 1 Cedar at 27 Damers Road.

(2) That Councillor T.C.N. Harries be elected Chairman of the Panel for the ensuing year.

13. <u>CONSULTATION ON IMPROVEMENTS TO THE POLICY AND LEGAL</u> FRAMEWORK FOR PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

The Committee received and considered copy documents from DEFRA and Natural England regarding the Government's proposals to make changes to the policy and legal framework governing public rights of way.

RESOLVED

That the Vice-Chairman together with Councillors E.S. Jones and D. Roberts be authorised to respond to the document on behalf of the Council.
