REASON: In the interests of neighbouring amenity.

• The premises shall be used as a fertility clinic only and for no other purpose (including any other purpose in Class D1 of the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987, as amended, or in any provision equivalent to that Class in any statutory instrument revoking and re-enacting that Order.

REASON: The Council considers an unrestricted Class D1 use may not be compatible with the living conditions of surrounding residential properties.
